Outcome. I know the importance of honesty.

Teaching and Learning.	
<p>Circle time. Button, button. An adult should choose one child to be "it" while the other children gather in a circle. The person who is "it" closes her eyes. A button, or other small object is passed from person to person until an amount of time passes. The adult could set a timer or play some music for the button passing time. When the person who is "it" opens her eyes the group says "Button, button, who's got the button?" while they are all pretending to hide the button in their hands. The person who is "it" will then guess a person. The person with the button can take a turn to be "it" next. While this game seems like simple fun, there's a desire for some kids to lie when they hold the button and the person who is "it" guesses their name. It feels like they're getting caught even though it's just fun. Adults can discuss why everyone needs to tell the truth, and how that keeps the game fun for everyone.</p>	
<p>Mindfulness Remind children that in order to learn we need to be calm.</p>	<p>Are we calm and ready to learn?</p>

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Children to sit in a comfortable position and close their eyes.
Adult to ring a chime. Children to breathe normally listening to the chime. Open eyes when no longer can hear chime.
