Outcome-I know how to cooperate as part of a team.	
<p>Resources Chime Cooperation poster-print off to display in classroom. Construction bricks Well-being books or paper for drawings.</p>	<p>Vocabulary Team Cooperation Compromise Sharing Achieve Goal Contribute</p>
<p>Teaching and Learning. Circle time. Have a box of construction bricks in the centre of the circle. Tell the children we want to make a tall tower and each person can only have one brick each. What shall we do? In turn ask the children to help with building the tallest tower.</p> <p>Mindfulness Watch Cosmic Kids Zen Den or use classroom mindfulness calming activity. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uUIGKhG_Vq8</p> <p>Tell me Remind children about the last few sessions about friendships and friendly behaviours. Now separate children into groups of 4 or 5. Tell the children we are going to make music. One group will clap, one will tap gently on chairs or tables, one group will whistle or make whooshing sounds with their mouths, one group can click their fingers etc. Each group plays their sound when you point to them. The object is for each</p>	<p>Did we achieve our end goal? How do you feel?</p> <p>Are we calm and ready to learn and listen?</p> <p>How did you work together? How did the music sound? Would you change anything?</p>

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group to get itself coordinated into something that sounds good without talking to the other member(s) of the group. In order to accomplish this, they have to listen to what each other is doing and adjust accordingly. Next in turn add the groups until all are playing together.

Tell children that this working together is called cooperation.

Cooperation is when we all work together to achieve the same end.

Display poster and work through cooperative behaviours.

Can the children name things they do at school, in the classroom or playground or at home which requires them to be cooperative?
