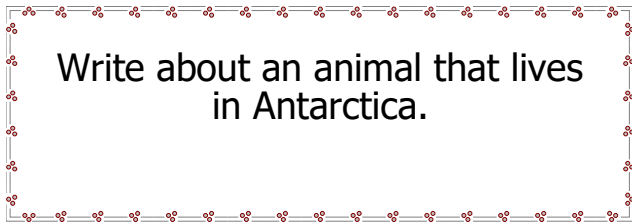

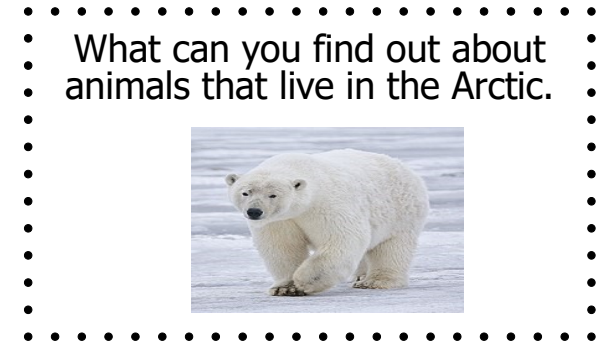

Animals**



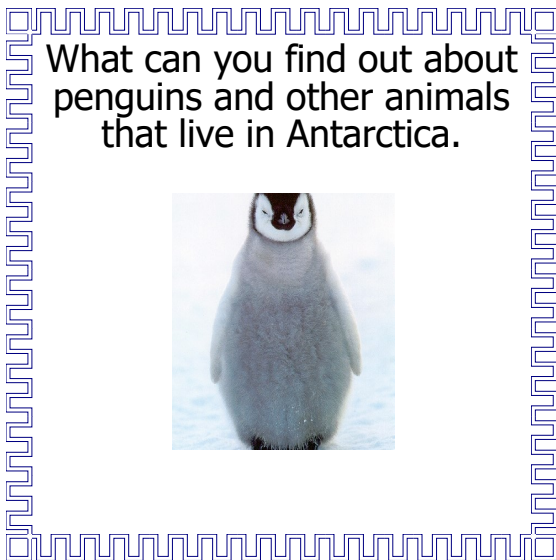
Write about an animal that lives in Antarctica.



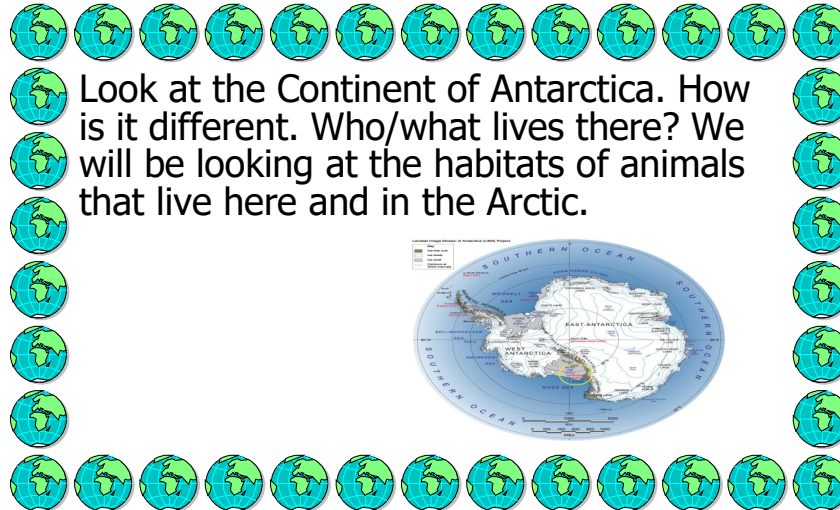
What can you find out about animals that live in the Arctic.



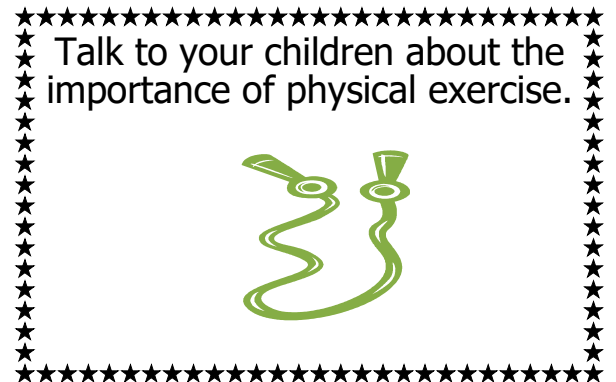
Look at your garden or your local park. Have you noticed any changes to how it looked in the summer?



What can you find out about penguins and other animals that live in Antarctica.

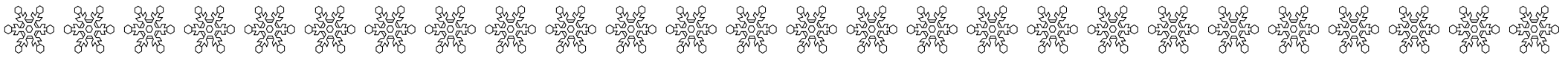


Look at the Continent of Antarctica. How is it different. Who/what lives there? We will be looking at the habitats of animals that live here and in the Arctic.

How can you support your child's learning?

Count things at home. How many if it is 1 more or 1 less? Practise counting back from 20.

Encourage your child to write at home. Encourage them to spell simple words using the segmenting and blending books which will be coming home soon.

Well done for sharing books with your child please continue to do this including bedtime stories.

- Practice the letter names and sounds of the alphabet e.g. when sharing books. Play I Spy with them.
- Practice writing your whole name forming the letters correctly.
- Practise writing sentences.
